Skill

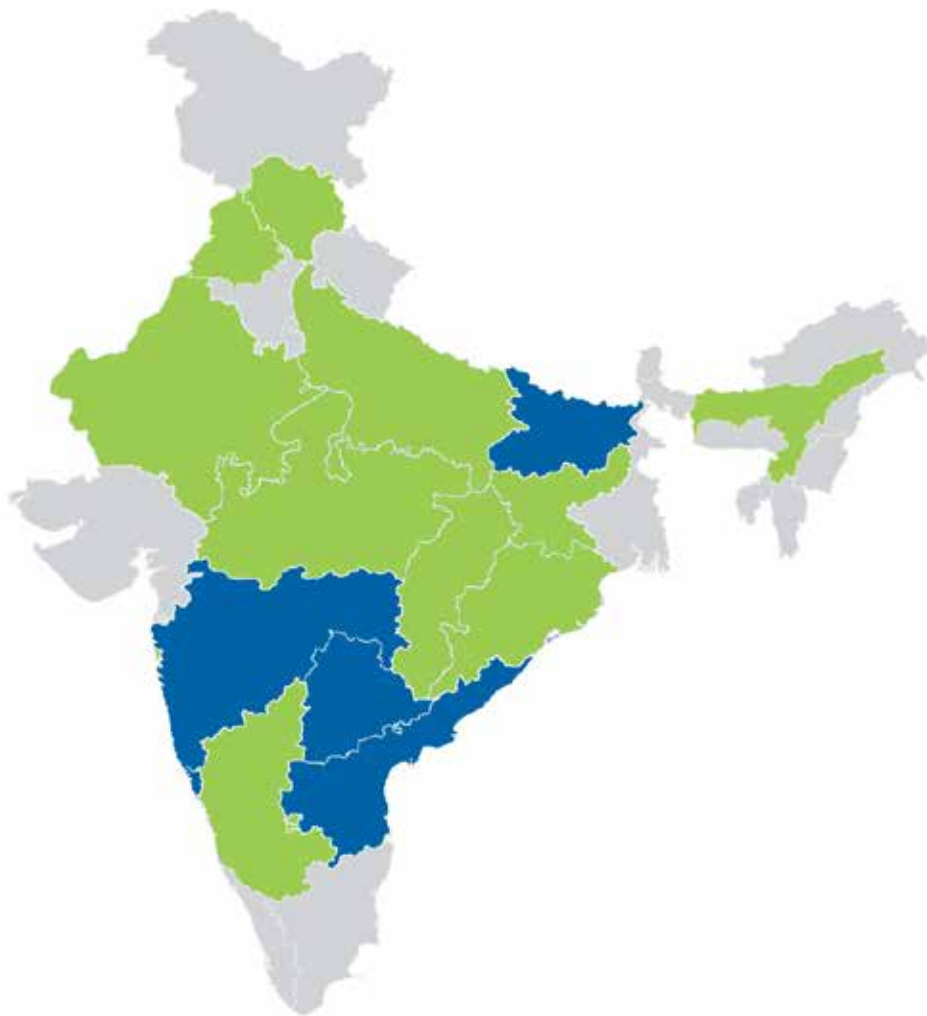
